

Board of Trustees News December 2016

The Halcombe Board of Trustees has had its final meeting for the year.

- The Board received a student achievement report for Maths Number Knowledge results for the year - 91% of our students are at or above expectation in Number Knowledge - an outstanding result.
- Other reports tell us that most of our students' achievement is "at or above" National Standards in the critical areas of Reading, Writing and Maths. A huge "well done" to the whole team at Halcombe School.
- The Board is continuing to develop its 10-year property plan and is receiving specialist reports on the general standard of our school. This is part of the process that we, as the Board, must complete and it ties into presenting a school that meets health and safety standards across many aspects of the school. This overall 10-year plan is a long process with carefully measured steps for us a Board to follow. This plan will also help us identify new infrastructure projects during the development of our plan, for example innovative learning environments, if this is found to be suitable and an advantage to our school.
